PARADE RULES

1. Entries should match the theme.
2. There must be NO ONE DRESSED AS SANTA with any entry.
3. Lights and music are encouraged for every entry.
4. All entries must have a registration form completed and signed.
5. Small children must be on a float or accompanied by adult with walking group.
6. Lineup will be on South Main Street. Floats will be on the street, riding units in parking lot at Williams Petroleum and walking units in parking lot of the old hospital.
7. Four-Wheelers will be allowed, but a 5mph speed limit will be strictly enforced. Those that cannot abide by the rules will be asked by the police to depart from the parade route. All four wheels shall remain on the ground at all times.
8. To ensure public safety, NO LIVESTOCK with the exception of horses, will be allowed in the parade. If your club has horses participating in the parade it is your responsibility to clean up after them. This policy will be strictly enforced by the Arab Police Department.
9. To ensure public safety, NO CANDY can be **THROWN** from entries but it will be allowed to distribute (hand out) candy from entries in Parade.
10. Floats must not be taller from ground to tip than 14'.
11. **Please** - have a plan for your group - where to meet and where to pick up! Make sure they know that if they get lost - look for individuals wearing the orange vests for help.
